

CPCC Objectives

In response to citizen concerns, a coalition of citizen interest groups was formed to:


- Implement a Water Quality Monitoring Program for Punta Gorda canals and city waterways.
- Validate or negate the FDEP impairment designation.
- Work with regional and national experts on fecal indicator bacteria to conduct investigation into source(s) and risk, if any.
- Develop potential mitigation strategies for addressing sources of concern.


When/How/What we monitor

- 1st Monday of each month Land based
- Water samples collected for enterococci analysis/DNA analysis
- Field Measurements
 - pH
 - Dissolved Oxygen
 - Specific Conductivity
 - Salinity
- Field Observations
 - Water Clarity, Color, Temp
 - Field Conditions
